Equipment List

A1 Drawing Board - this is essential and will last forever!

Memory Stick 512MB

Steel ruler - at least 50cm long

Dip pen and range of nibs

Range of pencils

Graphite sticks

Rubber

Glue - Pritt type stick

Gouache

Inks (quality, not quantity; Winsor and Newton are best. Black ink essential)

Scissors

Scalpel & blades

Craft knife

Chalk/pastel fixative

Oil pastels (buy quality, not quantity!)

Chalk pastels (quality, not quantity!)

Coloured pencils

Felt pens (Berol or Staedler are best)

Masking tape

Brushes - a wide range of sizes (a few cheap decorators brushes as well!)

Drawing board clips x 4 are handy!

Sketchbooks, preferably hardback - a range of sizes, A3 and A5 are good (of good quality paper; Daler Rowney, Fabriano)

Collect old photographs, typography, patterns and packaging you find interesting etc

Anything else you can think of that has the potential to make interesting marks! This is a very basic list, be imaginative with your collection of media and tools.
