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1. PRINCIPLES

- Hereford College of Arts recognises the climate emergency is one of the most urgent problems facing human society and life on our planet.
- We recognise the interconnection of environmental and financial sustainability as embodied in the UN sustainable development agenda which says that 'For sustainable development to be achieved, it is crucial to harmonize three core elements: economic growth, social inclusion and environmental protection. 2. **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- The Principal with support of the Senior Leadership Team is designated with responsibility for delivering the strategy, aims and objectives
- Professional service and curriculum managers are responsible for supporting our objectives across their areas of responsibility

achievement of a sustainable college.

3 MONITORING

We will identify a set of performance indicators that are easily measurable with time limits set for achieving targets. We will establish baselines for these indicators first of all. Targets and progress will be monitored internally by the Wider Leadership Group, Senior Leadership Team and Student Council and will be reported to relevant Board Committees and to the Board.

4 ACTIONS

The college is committed to the following practices:

Concerning Estates and Operations

- Meet, and wherever possible exceed environmental legislative and other requirements
- Prevent pollution by managing and reducing emissions and discharges and using resources responsibly and efficiently
- Work with waste management companies that recycle the maximum amount of waste possible and send the minimum to landfill
- Segregate waste so that it can be recycled
- Ensure sustainability criteria are included in the College's purchasing processes.
- Ensure that new buildings and refurbishments take into account sustainability principles
- Ensure energy efficiency is considered when selecting products to purchase.
- Ensure sustainability is a criterion in selecting contractors
- Require improvements in sustainable practice in our catering

- Include sustainability as a part of curriculum development and continuous improvement plans
